



ISPA Best Current Practice Document

A Best Current Practice (BCP) document is a non-mandatory recommendation representing what ISPA believes is best practice at the time of writing. Prescriptive language including words like 'should' and 'would' refer to members who are trying to comply with the BCP. Mandatory requirements on ISPA members are set out in the ISPA Code of Practice.

1. Relationship with IWF

The ISPA Code of Practice requires members to provide Secretariat with a point of contact and to comply with take down notices issued by the Internet Watch Foundation.

Members should display a link to the IWF on their own website to demonstrate their support for the IWF. It is recommended that Members also consider taking individual membership of the IWF, where possible.
